## AIT FELLOWSHIPS FOR MASTERS DEGREE

Fellowship	Value of fellowship grant	Cumulative GPA requirement
100%	672,000 Baht (covers entire study cost of 4 semesters)	GPA $\geq$ 3.50
75%	504,000 Baht (covers 3 semesters, student pays remainder 188,000 Baht as one-semester cost)	GPA $\geq$ 3.00
50%	336,000 Baht (covers 2 semesters, student pays same amount for 2 semesters)	GPA $\geq$ 2.75

## AIT FELLOWSHIPS FOR DOCTORAL DEGREE

Applicants should have a Cumulative GPA of 3.50 in their Master's degree and 2.75 in their Undergraduate program from top universities.

## ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:

1. Students of all nationalities are eligible.
2. Attain a satisfactory English Requirements.
3. Priority is given to Master degree applicants.
4. A four-year Bachelor degree from a recognized university is required.
5. MBA applicants require an additional one-year of relevant work experience.

### Please note:

1. Fellowships cover tuition, but do not cover registration fees, accommodation fees or living expenses.
2. Please be informed that the above scheme is to be used as guidelines of the Selection Committee, but not necessary means that every applicant with the required GPA will receive the corresponding amount of the fellowship. The final decision will rest totally with the Selection Committee.
