Visa Procedures	Visa Requirements: X1 or X2 Visa Visa Procedure: Students apply for visa after they receive the admission letter and		
	JW201/202 visa application form, usually within 40 days after the application deadline.		
Insurance Required	As requested by relevant national regulations and school requirements, during the registration international students must purchase group insurance for international students studying in China which is provided by Ping'an Insurance Company. As an alternative, students can buy the insurance for international students offered by China Ping'an Company online. Details will be provided in the admission handbook. Scholarships students whose admission notice indicate insurance coverage are not required to purchase insurance.		
Airport Pick-up	Students need to apply it online after being admitted at http://apply.bnu.edu.cn/		
Service	Pick-up service may not available due to COVID-19.		
Physical Examination Required	Students who hold X1 visa need to do physical examination at designated hospitals in home country, or they can do it in China after arrival at Beijing Normal University. It is highly suggested to do the physical examination in your home country due to the COVID-19.
