SPEAKER'S PROFILE

JIN Ligun President and Chair of the **Board of Directors** Asian Infrastructure Investment Bank

Mr. Jin Liqun is the inaugural President and Chair of the Board of Directors of the Asian Infrastructure Investment Bank. Before being elected as the Bank's first President. he served as Secretary-General of the Multilateral Interim Secretariat tasked with establishing the Bank. President Jin has rich experience across the private and public sectors and with MDBs. He served as Chair of China International Capital Corporation Limited - China's first joint-venture investment bank, Chair of the Supervisory Board of China Investment Corporation and Chair of the International Forum of Sovereign Wealth Funds. He previously served as Vice President and then Ranking Vice President of the Asian Development Bank and as Alternate Executive Director for China at the World Bank and at the Global Environment Facility. President Jin spent nearly two decades at the Chinese Ministry of Finance, reaching the rank of Vice Minister.
