Guidelines for artwork submissions

All submissions must be an attachment of your work addressed to **suculgen@ait.ac.th.** You must be the owner of your work and the attached picture must be of satisfactory picture quality to be printed and exhibited. Your accompanying text should include your name, student id, contact number and a title for your work. The text should be legible. Any artwork without a title will be disqualified.

Artwork guidelines

- 1. Produce an artwork that you would like to publish in the campus to mark the Global Centenary International Women's day. Artworks can be paintings, photographs, drawings, collage or posters.
- 2. The artwork must include a gender element to it and the purpose of this artwork competition.
- 3. There will be three winners from the adult category who will receive cash prize and three winners from the children category who will receive attractive gift hampers.

Artwork requirements

- 1. All artwork is to be submitted in photograph format or pdf format.
- 2. You can also submit a hard copy. All hard copies must be submitted to Mr. Poom (SU office secretary) between 10 AM to 4 PM on working days.
- 3. Picture upload dimensions should not exceed a maximum of 5 MB.
- 4. Pictures of artwork should be in .jpg format
- 5. The artwork must be original and must have a title.

How will the best artwork be selected?

There will a judging committee who will be responsible for the selection of the best artworks.

What is the deadline for submitting artwork?

International Women's Day is 8th March, but due to this late notice we request you to send in your entries by the 14th March, 12:00 midnight.
