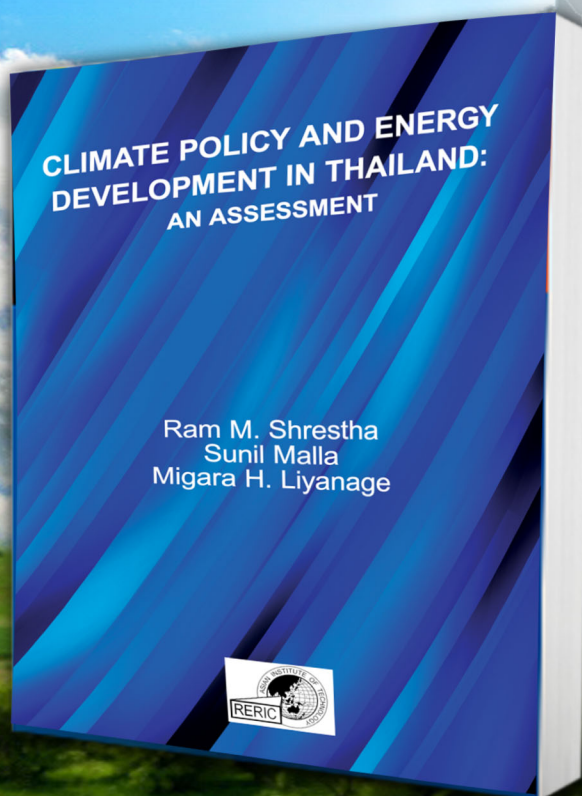


CLIMATE POLICY AND ENERGY DEVELOPMENT IN THAILAND: AN ASSESSMENT

This book examines the long term implications of various climate-friendly policies on energy system development, associated greenhouse gases and other environmental emissions in Thailand. Current overview of energy and environmental trends and climate-friendly policies in Thailand are presented. Specific issues such as GHG emission reduction targets and their co-benefits; promotion of biofuels in the transport sector; multi-gas emissions; and energy development and environmental emissions under different socio-economic scenarios were also analyzed.

It includes chapters on analysis of the economy-wide effects of low carbon measures with emission trading carbon capture and storage technology during 2005-2025. Most of the analyses use a long-term energy system model of Thailand (i.e. Thailand AIM/Enduse model); two chapters utilized a MARKAL based energy system model and AIM CGE model.

This 230-page book will be of interest to policy makers, researchers, and other individuals or organizations involved in energy, environmental and climate change policy issues in developing countries in general and Thailand in particular.
